CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

- 1 **Prosecco Brut NV, Veneto, Italy**
A wonderfully fragrant nose of fresh plump fruits such as apricot, peach and flowers. This is all replicated on the palate, a very 'pretty' prosecco made with only the best grapes and an absolute pleasure to drink.
- 2 **Le Mesnil Champagne, Blanc de Blancs Grand Cru, France**
100% Chardonnay from the exceptional Grand Cru village of Le Mesnil-Sur-Oger in the Côte des Blancs - the finest village for Chardonnay in all of Champagne. The wine offers intensity, minerality and a depth of flavour - citrus, brioche and mushroom with brilliant freshness and life.
- 3 **Veuve Cliquot NV, Champagne, France**
An archetypal Champagne from an historic house. Richness of fruit on the palate with a mouth filling delicate bubble mousse and a long finish.

WHITES

- 4 **Berry Bros & Rudd Merchant's White, Viura blend, Spain 2016/17**
Pleasing notes of peach and stone fruits. Dry but light, and lifted by a pinch of minerality.
- 5 **Pinot Grigio, Italy, 2016/17**
Classic Pinot Grigio that balances clarity and freshness with a light body and fresh aromas of white peach and lime blossom, followed by a vibrant palate and a fresh, fruit-driven finish.
- 6 **Le Chapeau qui Rit Blanc, Ugni Blanc/Colombard Blend, France, 2016/17**
A lovely zingy, fresh and aromatic white, made in Gascony which is also where they make Armagnac.
- 7 **Kraal Bay, Chenin Blanc, Swartland, South Africa, 2017**
Light apple and pear fruit on the nose and palate. Soft, not bone dry, so pairs well with lightly spiced foods, light seafood and on its own. A lovely weight and richness around the edges, but crisp and refreshing at its core - a perfect balance!
- 8 **No Stone Unturned Semillon/Chardonnay, Murray Darling, Australia, 2016**
Semillon's trademark waxy character is brought to bear against the bright, crisp freshness of the Chardonnay. The style is one of fresh simplicity with the richness of the Semillon.
- 9 **Château Fontarèche, Viognier, Vin de Pays d'Oc, France, 2016**
Light to medium bodied with notes of apricot followed by a lovely clean finish. A great example of Viognier!
- 10 **Berry Bros & Rudd Merchant's Range New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, 2016/2017**
A traditional Sauvignon Blanc from Marlborough with a subtle balance of crisp grapefruit and gooseberry, followed by a clean refreshing finish.
- 11 **Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine Félines Jourdan, France, 2016**
Light and clean on the palate with green apple notes and floral hints. A delicious wine from the Languedoc in the south-west.
- 12 **Grüner Veltliner, Von den Terrassen, Josef Ehmoser, Wagram, Austria, 2016**
Grüner Veltliner offers wonderful minerality and freshness along with a richness on the palate. A fantastic alternative to other styles and a must try!
- 13 **Albariño, Igrexario de Saia, Bodega Sucesores de Benito Santos, Spain, 2016**
Albariño is one of the more aromatic grape varieties offering subtle hints of peach and apricot on the pallet. Great on its own or with seafood.
- 14 **Chablis, Domaine du Colombier, Burgundy, France, 2015/16**
This wine has the perfect balance of bright fruit and sizzling mineral precision. Unadulterated by oak, it lends itself to a wide variety of food pairings, including (of course) shellfish and seafood dishes.
- 15 **Pouilly-Fuisse, Vieilles Vignes, Domaine des Deux Roches, Burgundy, France, 2015**
A true classic from Burgundy. Gold coloured, this wine has an intense brioche aroma with hints of stone fruits and flowers, and a restraint that hints at its minerality. A complex palate of green apples, with traces of citrus and creamy oak notes, that builds to an impressive finish.
- 16 **Meursault, Jean-Philippe Fichet, Burgundy, France, 2015**
A beautiful Meursault with gorgeous flavours of almonds, hints of white flowers and fresh, crunchy nectarines followed by buttery, toasty, ripe fruit characters with modest weight.

22 Le Chapeau qui Rit Rouge, Hérault, Languedoc, France, 2016/17 Warm hearted residents (grapes) of the South of France; Grenache, mainstay for the famously ripe and fruity Chateauf-neuf-du-Pape, and Cinsault. Plenty of subtle hedgerow fruit with a hint of sweet spice.				£21.00
23 Viña Doña Javiera, Merlot, Maipo, Chile, 2016 Soft, plummy fruit comes to the fore on the palate with layers of intense blackberry fruit. The finish is deliciously rounded, smooth and fresh with a hint of sweet morello cherry.	£4.50	£6.85	£8.90	£23.75
24 The Merchant's Rioja, Crianza, Spain, 2014 An enticing nose of sweet blackberries leads on to a broad, rich palate brimming with dark fruit and mocha chocolate. The power of this wine is clear, yet it is smooth and subtle with real depth.	£4.95	£7.45	£9.75	£25.85
25 Berry Bros & Rudd Traditional Claret, Bordeaux, France 2014 Plenty of red and black fruits, ripe tannins and a delicious finish. Soft and silky, this is a sophisticated wine which is perfect for drinking now.				£26.50
26 Domaine de la Rocaille, Beaujolais, Vieilles Vignes, France, 2017 Outstanding example of the Gamay grape - considerably more gutsy and full flavoured than might be expected from a Beaujolais. Great with light meat dishes, cold meats and even roasts.				£28.50
27 Chianti, Colli Senesi, Italy, 2014 Brick red in colour with a nose of cherries and spice. Medium body and mild tannins make it all too easy to drink.				£30.95
28 Bourgogne Rouge, Henri Prudhon, Pinot Noir, France, 2015 Medium-bodied fresh and elegant red with classic Pinot Noir cherries, raspberries and blackberries. The palate is juicy and crisp with subtle oak spice.	£5.75	£8.65	£11.50	£31.50
29 Rocky Gully Shiraz, Western Australia, 2015 (Organic) Power refinement and finesse, this Shiraz aims to capture all the quintessential fruit opulence, black pepper and spice notes for which the region has become renowned.				£32.00
30 Pulenta Estate Malbec, Argentina, 2015 A wonderful Single Estate Malbec, run by the same family since 1902. Aromas of red strawberries and cherries, balanced with spicy notes of the oak. 31 Au Bon Climat, Pinot Noir, Santa Barbara, USA, 2016 This is one of the top 4 wine makers in the USA - Jim Clemenden. He learnt his trade making wine in Burgundy and took it to California. His Pinot Noirs are elegant, rich and full of finesse with soft red cherry fruit and a wonderful finish. A real treat.				£45.00
32 Châteauf-neuf-du-Pape, Domaine des Saumades, Rhone, France, 2015 Generous aromas of blueberry, forest floor and thyme; with an impressive texture in the mouth, which marries firm, yet silky tannins and a fulsome, seductive core of fruit.				£50.00
33 Château Bellegrave, Pomerol, France, 2008 Blackberry, cherry, vanilla and earthy fruit aroma. Firm fruit with good perfume, a lovely minerality and iron notes from the Pomerol soil. This is a very elegant and rich wine from the Right Bank of Bordeaux and a very good drinking vintage.				£75.00
34 Château Lagrange, St Julien, Bordeaux, France, 2010 A top third growth Bordeaux, highly rated by wine critics. This St Julien offers a good weight and depth of fruit with flavours of fresh blackberries, spices, cedar and chinese red dates. The nose is restrained but the palate is generous and full of flavour.				£120.00

36 Château Partarrieu, Sauternes, France, 2015 A vibrant, upfront Sauternes with simple ripe pineapple flavours and not too sweet, but light and elegant with good acidity.	£9.95	£38.00
